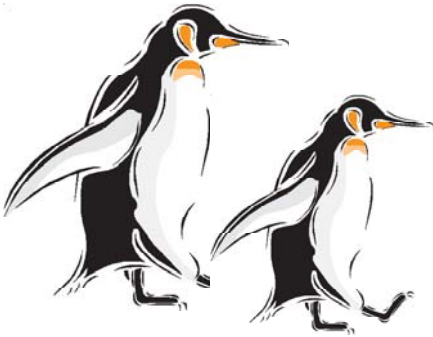

Happy New Year!

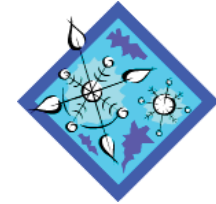

Bring Someone You Love Day – Feb. 12



Our “Bring Someone You Love” day at MLC is a chance to see your child working in the classroom. Each child may bring one guest (an aunt, uncle, grandparent or adult friend could come instead of a parent) to share activities of their choice, then sing songs and take home a special treat.

Part-time children who don't normally attend on this day are welcome to come with their guests. Because there will be double the number of people in the classroom on this day, only half the class attends at one time, and for a shorter class period. Enrolment for the 2010-11 School Year

We realize that next fall seems a long time away. However, in order to allow new parents early opportunities to register their children for the next school year, we ask parents of returning children to re-register by Friday, Feb. 6.

Registration packages will be sent home with all MLC families whose children are eligible to re-enroll. Siblings of returning children are also invited to register at this time.

According to Montessori educational philosophy, children benefit most from a Montessori program by attending for three years. We hope all our currently enrolled three and four year olds will return next fall.

Our goal is to especially encourage parents of four year olds to continue at MLC through their Kindergarten year. As you know, the MLC Kindergarten

program meets provincial curriculum standards plus offers enriched learning experiences through the Montessori method.

The teachers would be happy to discuss any concerns or questions you may have about enrolment for the next year.

Each year, we have a number of Kindergarten children who attend our program for the whole day, either every day of the week or for one to four days. A lunch program has been in place for those children who stay all day, and for any other children who need extra time for pick-up in the morning, or who need to be dropped off earlier for the afternoon class. Space is limited.

In the Classroom

January Activities



All areas of the classroom will reflect a progression of skill building. The *Practical Life* area will contain activities that need more dexterity and attention to detail, for example: dry and wet pouring 1-3; pouring to a line; using eye droppers, tweezers, whisks, hole puncher ; cutting along a line – straight, angular, curved or circular – with scissors.

In the *Sensorial area*, we plan to show the children extensions to, and different ways of working with the basic Montessori equipment (i.e., the broad stair, the pink tower, cylinder blocks, knobless cylinders, long red rods, and constructive triangles). We will also present more advanced work as the months progress.

Language and Math areas will continue to offer activities for all levels of development in our classroom. Equipment and materials are changed regularly so the children are always finding new ways to reinforce the basic concepts of sounds and quantity.

We will begin a study of the continent of South America this month, learning about the people, and some animals and their habitats. We will listen to music and stories, and learn games and dances. If parents have any artifacts, art or articles of interest that come from South America and want to share them with the class for the duration of the study, please talk to a teacher.



French (Tuesdays)

The children are continuing to learn and practise French through songs, stories and conversations. We practise greeting each other, counting to ten, then to twenty, and we learn the colours.

We will learn more words to describe the winter weather, our mood today and body parts.
