Bring Someone you Love Day

Friday, February 12, 2010 is a special day for all MLC families. Each child can bring one guest to stay with them in the classroom, watch them work and work with them, sing songs as a group, and enjoy being together in a shortened class period.

In order to accommodate everyone, we have set up an alphabetical schedule based on the children's last names. For example, if your child's last name is Anderson, they would come with their guest at 8:45 a.m. and leave at 10:00a.m., or in the afternoon, come at 1:00 p.m. and leave at 2:15 p.m.

If your child's last name is Smith they would come with their guest from 10:15 to 11:30 a.m. or 2:30 to 3:45 p.m. Please ensure your child and guest come to school at the correct time. Children who attend part time and normally do not attend school on Fridays are welcome.

Parents who would like to make cookies for a small valentine treat bag for the children are asked to speak to Judy in the office.

There will be no lunch program on Bring Someone You Love Day-Friday, February 12.

Valentine Cards

The classroom BANK turns into the MLC POST OFFICE from February 4-11. Cards can be brought to the "post office" any day between Feb. 4-11...the earlier the better. The children take turns stamping and delivering cards, which they can make at school or bring from home if they wish. The name of the child the card is being sent to should be printed clearly on the envelope or on the back of the card. Remember to bring in the cards by February 11. An up-to-date class list is attached. You don't have to wait until all your child's cards are signed to bring them to school; send a few each day. The post office will be closed on the 12th Bring Someone You Love Day.

Reminders for Parents

Morning drop-off is at 8:45 a.m. and pick-up is at 11:30a.m. A few parents have made prior arrangements for early drop-off at 8:30a.m. and have prepaid for this option.

The same goes for the afternoon program, which starts at 1 p.m. and dismisses at 3:45p.m. Some parents have made arrangements to pick up their children at 4p.m. and have prepaid for this option.

Parents who have not made these arrangements to drop off early, and who arrive early, must stay with their child until the classroom opens officially at 8:45 a.m. This policy is in the interest of fairness to all.

If parents are unavoidably detained either in the morning or afternoon, a penalty charge of \$1 should be paid. All the children must be picked up by 4:00 to allow time for the teachers to prepare for the next day.

If parents do not want their child to play outside (for any reason-

health, schedule, no snow pants), they should arrive 15 minutes early to pick up their child before the class goes outside. All the staff are needed outdoors to supervise the children, and office work also needs to get done.

Parents, please remember that no parking is allowed at the sidewalk intersections at Balfour and Mabel or at Ashland and Mabel. Parking there is hazardous for pedestrians from our school, the daycare nearby, and the disabled.

Abe, the caretaker, reminds parents not to park in the “tempting” space beside the garbage bin on Ashland Ave.

Please be sure to send a complete change of clothing in your child’s backpack. Don’t forget the underwear and socks!!!!

Parents-MLC needs spare children’s clothing sizes 5-6x- sweatshirts, mitts, t-shirts, pants and socks for those times when a second change of clothing is required. Thank you in advance.
